The Department of Urology is conducting an internally funded clinical trial on Empiric versus Culture-based management of an acute cystitis episode in adult women with a history of recurrent urinary tract infections.



PURPOSE	INCLUSION	INCLUDES
To compare the efficacy of antibiotic treatment prescribed empirically or based on urine culture for an acute cystitis episode in adult women with a history of recurrent urinary tract infections.	We are recruiting women between 18-85 years old with a documented history of recurrent urinary tract infections, who are experiencing an acute cystitis episode for which they will require an antibiotic treatment.	This study requires up to 3 interactions with our research team, first at baseline, second before antibiotic therapy and third one week later. These interactions can be completed over the phone or during an office visit.
